Supply List:

2 - 60" circular needles, in the proper size for yarn selection **-or-**

1 – 60"circular needle and a long cable with two end caps like KnitPicks brand

DK weight yarn: e.g. 200 g DK variegated yarn with long color runs and 200 g matching solid (300m/100g), and US5 needles -or-

Worsted weigh yarn: e.g. 250 g Worsted weight variegated yarn with long color runs, 150 g matching solid yarn (200m/100g), and US8 needles.
